

#### Sound Move

- Sound Transit is building over 12,000 park & ride spaces at 25 facilities
- Sound Transit provides bus and/or rail service at over 50 park & rides





### **Sound Transit 2**

## If approved by voters this November:

- 100,000 new hours of bus service
- 65% more Sounder commuter rail
  - More trips
  - Longer trains
- 36 miles new light rail
  - New P&Rs possible at many stations
- Improved access, parking
  - Up to 9,000 additional stalls
