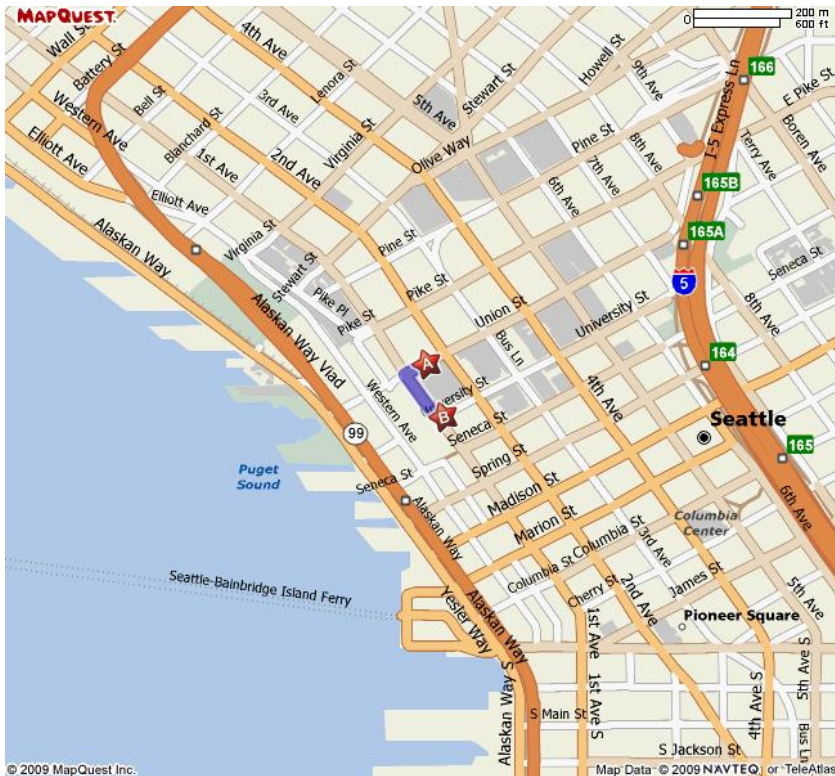


Premiere Screening of

Directions to Event



Heading North on I-5: take I-5 to Seneca Street exit (#165), west on Seneca Street to First Avenue, and turn right (north). Turn right on Union and garage is the second opening on the right.

Heading South on I-5: take I-5 to Union Street exit (#165B), west (toward Puget Sound) on Union Street to First Avenue. Garage is first opening on the left, it is permissible to cross yellow dividing line to enter garage.

From I-90: Heading west, merge onto I-5 North, take Madison Street exit (#2C). Turn left on Madison and right on First Avenue. Turn right on Union and garage is the second opening on the right.

NOTE: The auditorium entrance is located on First Avenue on the corner of University Street (Point B). But parking will be in the Chase Center Parking Garage (Point A).

Entrance is below the SAM building on Union Street between First and Second Avenues. Cost is between \$5 to \$7 and garage accepts cash and credit cards.

This is an **ADA-accessible garage**; it has an elevator that will leave you **around the corner** from the museum's main entrance at 1st and Union. The 1st and Union doors will not be open at this time - **You will need to go down 1st Avenue to the University entrance to get into our event.**

TRAFFIC ADVISORY: There is quite a bit of construction going on in Downtown Seattle and a Mariner's baseball game on 8/8/09. Please plan in 20-30 minutes extra into your commute.
