• What is ITS: Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) are a broad range of communications-based information, control, and electronic technologies. ITS reduces fuel consumption by increasing mobility and reducing vehicle miles traveled

 - Collision Avoidance Systems
 - Driver Assistance Systems
 - Collision Notification Systems

 - Arterial Management
 - Freeway, Transit, and Incident Management
 - Electronic Payment and Pricing
 - Traveler Information
 - Information Management
 - Crash Prevention and Safety
 - Roadway Operations and Maintenance
 - Road Weather Management
 - Commercial Vehicle Operations
 - Intermodal Freight

ITS: a Logical and Cost-Effective Solution

- Traveler Information
 - GPS and Navigation Systems
- Congestion Pricing
 - Price use of broad geographic areas (*e.g.*, downtown business districts)
 - o Optical recognition of license plates to confirm enrollment
 - o GPS devices or odometer sensors
- Toll Roads
 - Variable High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes
- Drive-by weigh stations




ITS: a Logical and Cost-Effective Solution (Transit)

- Advanced Communications Systems
 - Effective and efficient operation of transit systems relies on a communications infrastructure and vehicle-based communications technologies
- Transit Operations Software
 - Helps the operator monitor the fleet's performance in meeting demand, identify incidents, manage response, and restore service more effectively
- Automated Fare Payment
 - Reduce costs through increased automation and enhancing customer convenience
- Bus Rapid Transit







ITS America's Environmental Program: Promote Environmental Benefits of ITS

- Legislation: Through a broad coalition of governments, industry, NGOs, and trade association, we will ensure that climate change and transportation legislation recognizes ITS as a solution to reduce GHGs
- **Regulations and public policy**: Support regulatory programs that use ITS to enhance the environment
